## ATS 10-Year Accreditation

During the 2021-22 Academic Year JST went through the Association of Theological Schools (ATS) reaccreditation process, which culminated in a site visit that occurred in March, 2022. The final report, which was approved by the ATS in June 2022, recommended the reaccreditation of our school and its programs for the next ten years, without a need for interim site visits in that period. The report underlined a number of our school's strengths, while noting areas on which we have opportunity to improve. The ATS report on our school, as well as the standards on which that report is based, will function as an important guide for the direction our school will be taking in the years ahead. In addition to receiving approbation from WASC in 2016 to offer an online Master of Theological Studies degree, JST received June 7, 2022 approbation from the Association of Theological Schools of Canada and the United States (ATS) to offer that degree.

## Graduate Research Symposium (Global Theology Initiative)

On September 20, 22, and 23, 2021 JST hosted on Zoom the first edition of the Graduate Research Symposium of the Global Theology Initiative that connects the seven English-speaking Jesuit theologates in the world located in New Delhi (India), Pune (India), Nairobi (Kenya), Manila (Philippines), Toronto (Canada), Boston, and Berkeley. The Symposium consisted of three 90-minute Zoom meetings during which students, selected by each school, presented their research for 20 minutes and took questions for 10 minutes. JST's Dean Joseph Mueller, S.J., built the foundation for this Symposium alongside Deans from the other theologates. To make things manageable, schools met in two clusters. One cluster included the schools from Delhi, Nairobi, Boston, and Toronto while the second cluster gathered the schools from Pune, Manila, and Berkeley. This event was successful: we had about 100 participants each night and there was no financial nor environmental cost. The three outstanding presenters for JST were Wilson Ngema (GTU PhD affiliated with JST), Ellie Martin (GTU MA affiliated with JST), and Albert Douglas Honegan (GTU PhD affiliated with JST).

## Latina/o Theology and Ministry Leadership Network

Under Dr. Cecilia Titizano, the construction of Latina/o Theology and Ministry Leadership Network is currently underway. SCU's Jesuit School of Theology, School of Education and Counseling Psychology, My Own Business Institute, and Graduate Program in Pastoral Ministries are expanding the range of theological and pastoral formation programs available in English and Spanish, diversifying modes of delivery, and seeking to build partnerships with other academic and national institutions. Finally, the Instituto Hispano is being re-imagined in dialogue with the Instituto's community.





## Community Events

Returning to campus gave our community a breath of fresh air as we were able to enjoy in-person events once again. Highlights included our celebrations of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Lunar New Year, our spring talent show (especially when everyone got up to do a popular line dance!), and our Commencement exercises, including a Lay Sending Mass and reception. As Professor and Associate Academic Dean Julie Rubio said, "These were moments when our school felt normal again—and they filled us with hope."

## Camino Ignaciano

This year brought the return of in-person immersion experiences. Camino Ignaciano – was a Spring 2022 course in history and spirituality with a summer immersion component that was a pilgrimage along the Camino Ignaciano in Spain, May 22-July 5, 2022.

Course materials included St. Ignatius' own writings, as well as critical texts by a diversity of modern authors and interpreters.

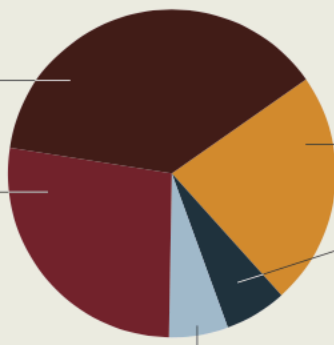

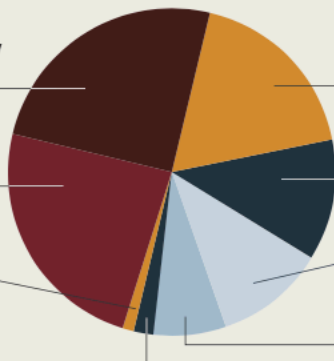
